Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and recommendations made to the Council for approval. Recipients will also receive a full year membership in CNCV. CNCV welcomes new members throughout the year and we encourage you to participate online and with us as our group transitions back to in person meetings and activities.

To apply please complete the one page application which follows. The goal of the scholarships is to support American Indians. Therefore preference will be given to Cherokee citizens and others with tribal affiliation. If you are under 18, we are requesting a parent's contact information as another way to contact you. The information in the application is considered private and will not be shared! We would like to announce your name and goals at our next CNCV meeting and on Facebook--with your permission!

Scholarships will be awarded in mid- to late-September.
